

DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY - TSCA

Your request: Toxic Substances Control Act ("TSCA")

On January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published new regulations under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h) to restrict the import and use of five persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals.

Imports of chemical substances, mixtures or articles that contain a chemical substance or mixture must comply with the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) in order to enter the U.S.

These chemicals include:

Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)	87-68-3

These substances are not use in our manufacturing process.

We confirm that all our products are not subject to TSCA.
