

CONFLICT MINERALS AND RESPONSIBLE MINERAL SOURCING STATEMENT

Innovative Sensor Technology IST AG (iST), a member of the Endress+Hauser Group, is committed to responsible business conduct and supports efforts to promote transparency and responsible sourcing practices within global mineral supply chains.

While iST is not subject to the reporting requirements of Section 1502 of the U.S. Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, we support our customers in meeting their compliance obligations and information requirements regarding conflict minerals and responsible mineral sourcing.

iST does not directly source minerals from mines, smelters or refiners and therefore relies on information provided by its suppliers regarding the origin and processing of minerals contained in supplied materials and components.

As part of our due diligence activities, relevant suppliers are requested to provide industry-standard reporting templates developed by the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI), including the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) and the Extended Minerals Reporting Template (EMRT). Information obtained through these declarations is reviewed and used to support supply chain transparency and customer inquiries.

In addition, iST requires suppliers to comply with its Supplier Code of Conduct, which includes expectations regarding ethical business practices and explicitly prohibits child labour, forced labour and other forms of modern slavery.

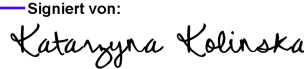
We remain committed to improving supply chain transparency and supporting responsible sourcing initiatives.
